Canyon View Spring Musical Committees and Volunteer Opportunities

Audition and Callback Committee

Assist with monitoring students during the audition and callback days. This committee does not sit in auditions or cast the Musical.

Treasurer

The Treasurer works with IPSF on budget, check requests, and income, including ticket sales, and concessions.

Vocal Assistant

The Vocal Assistant will work under the Director to assist with warming up students and individual help when needed.

Stage Manager

The Stage Manager works under the Producer and is in charge of sets, costumes, sound, and lighting.

Set Design Committee

Designs and builds sets for the performances. Duties include purchasing materials, and tear-down after last rehearsal. Majority of build time is evenings.

Costume Committee

Responsible for all costumes and props for performances. Will work with IPSF to secure costumes from Woodbury and rental company. Some hand sewing, and laundering required. Must be available during tech week and all performances in dressing rooms.

Sound and Lighting Committee

Responsible to run sound board, wireless microphones and spot lights during performances. Must be available during tech week for training and all performances.

Video and Photography

Responsible for video of the performance, editing, CD's and photography of performances.

Stage Crew Manager

The Stage Crew Manager works under the Producer and is in charge of the high school stage crew, backstage and dressing rooms.

Dressing Rooms

Assist with costumes, props, hair and makeup during performances.

Publicity Committee

The Publicity Committee is in charge of school publicity and signage.

Program Committee

The Program Committee works under the Volunteer Coordinator and is in charge of the Musical Program. This includes any ad sales and student bios.

Ticket Committee

The Ticket Committee is in charge of ticket sales, ticket printing and distribution. The Ticket Committee is also responsible for setting up and taking down the seating in the MPR for the performances.

Concessions Committee

The Concessions Committee is responsible for the purchasing and selling of concessions during the performances.

Social Committee

The Social Committee is responsible for the flowers, thank you gifts and cast party.

Class Monitor Committee

The Class Monitor Committee is responsible for securing parent volunteers to monitor every rehearsal. Members of this committee will be the only parents allowed in the MPR during rehearsals. The committee is also responsible for monitoring students snack time at the lunch tables.

Each parent volunteer committee will have a Committee Chair to manage the volunteers. Each parent is expected to assist with at least two jobs.
