Proposed Project List and Projects in Planning/Pending

Process for Creating the Proposed Project List

Throughout the School Facilities Improvement Measure (SFIM) planning process, IUSD staff has visited each school site within the School Facilities Improvement District to identify priority projects. School principals, staff, teachers, PTA members and parents have provided feedback and assisted the District with developing a proposed SFIM project list for their respective school sites.

After review by a Steering Committee, comprised of IUSD leadership, the following proposed project list was created in alignment with potential funding sources. Each school principal has reviewed and vetted the draft project list based on the unique needs of their school site and student community.

If the SFIM, also known as Measure E, is approved by voters this June, further refinement of the proposed project list will follow.

Timing for Implementing Proposed Projects

The approved bond resolution specifies a maximum available bond issuance of \$319 Million. This funding would be issued in four series over 12 years. Within each issuance there is a deadline of three years to expend the funds. The district anticipates the first bond issuance to occur in January or February of 2017. Once funds become available, a typical planning process and agency approval timeline would be from six to 18 months depending upon the size of the project. Construction timelines will vary based on the size of project. Implementation planning will occur over the next four months with the Steering Committee and options will be presented to the IUSD Board of Education if the bond passes in June. IUSD will regularly communicate important milestones and updates to school communities.

Technology Upgrades

Upgrade and replace network cabling and related equipment to ensure that every IUSD campus can support at least one device for every student in all instructional and collaborative work spaces on the campus. The work began in October 2015 and will continue through June 2018 (tentatively).
