What is CERT?

The Community Emergency Response Team (CERT), is a **Cost Free** program designed to prepare citizens to help themselves, their families and their neighbors in the event of a catastrophic disaster. Because professional emergency service personnel will not be able to help everyone immediately, CERT training can make a difference in saving lives and protecting property in our community. CERT training includes basic skills in disaster response including :

- Fire Suppression**
- First Aid**
- Light Search and Rescue**

Why CERT?

The skills you learn can save the lives of you and your family. You will be prepared to put out a live fire, handle difficult injuries, lift very heavy objects, understand how police and fire personnel handle large events, search buildings, and rescue victims. This training is extremely valuable to families as they organize their emergency plans.
