FAQs

Who qualifies to enroll?

Students in grades Kindergarten through 8th grade who reside within Irvine Unified School District are eligible to enroll. For students grades K-6, a parent or designated instructor must provide daily instruction at home. Middle School students will receive instruction and grades from a credentialed teacher in math, English, science and social studies.

What are the program costs?

San Joaquin Elementary and Middle Schools are free. We provide online curriculum for all core curriculum, as well as consumable workbooks for many texts. K-6 students will also be given supplies to support the curriculum.

May we use our own curriculum?

No, all students will use the online curriculum corresponding to California Common Core Standards. Parents can use their own materials as enrichment.

Is there a curriculum plan?

Yes, Course Contracts provide curriculum guidelines in Language Arts, Math, Social Studies, and Science for each grade level.

What are my responsibilities?

At the time of enrollment, parents will sign a Master Agreement that will include some of the following responsibilities:

1. To guide daily instruction (minimum of 4 hours a day) during normal school hours.
2. To submit a PE Log by the end of each Attendance Period. Students must demonstrate academic progress in the four core subjects as shown through the online curriculum.
3. To attend Parent, Student, Teacher conferences (minimum, Goal Setting Conference and End of the Year Conference).
4. To return all non-consumable materials at the end of the school year.
5. To maintain regular contact with your San Joaquin Elementary or Middle School supervising teacher.
